Honorable Councilmen and Councilwomen:

In January of this year, our office was appropriated \$39,802 for the purchase of a new vehicle for use in fulfillment of our duties as assigned. Rather than spend the full amount on a new vehicle, I was able to locate and purchase a low mileage used vehicle that was adequate for our needs. The goal was then to use the remaining funds to upfit the vehicle to provide greater safety while in use. The thought was that equipment new (44510) or equipment new other (44511) would be appropriate without further need of approvals. However, following the advice of Councilman Thompson, we are now requesting an out of series transfer for existing funds.

Request: An out of series transfer for the following:

\$4,000 from Vehicles (44460 existing funds) to safety (35000) for the purchase and installment of safety lights for the new (to us) vehicle.

RE: Request to amend to the 2025 Salary Ordinance

Dear Honorable County Council Members,

Please consider this letter as a formal request to be placed on the Council's Log for the meeting April 1, 2025, and to be voted on April 8, 2025. I am asking the Council to approve an amendment to the 2025 Salary Ordinance for the re-structuring of positions within the Vigo County Home for Children Budget for the Youth Care Specialists and the Night Guard.

I came before the Council in March to re-organize the administrative staff. I advised the Council that this was a two (2) phase process and now we are moving to the second phase of the re-organization of the Group Homes.

I was recently appointed as the Director of the Vigo County Homes for Children and at that time met with members of the Indiana Division of Child Services (DCS) and the Commissioners to see how to better manage the operations of the group homes in general. In those meetings, we concluded that maintaining the "House Parent Model" is antiquated, stress filled, and difficult to hire. Therefore, it needs to change to a shift/hourly schedule. Below is a list of changes that I am requesting that the County Council grant. They are as follows:

- 1. Group Homes Youth Care Specialists (4) positions
- Daily rate of \$257.58 to hourly rate of \$22.53
- 3. Group Homes Night Guard title to Youth Care Specialist
- Grade 7, hourly rate \$19.91 to Grade 9, hourly rate \$22.53(2)
- Grade 7, hourly rate \$19.87 to Grade 9, hourly rate \$22.53 (1)

We need to change their dynamics and operational models of the Group Homes. These changes, if approved, will allow us to utilize staff that directly manage the children in the most efficient way possible.

We would like to move these positions from a 48-hour workday...to 12 hours shift work. The rate of pay given to me from the Auditor's Office would be the same if converted to hourly wages. The pay would change from \$257.58/day to \$22.53/hour. This would require NO NEW APPROPRIATIONS as there is plenty of money already in the budget for 2025.

Then we would ask that the title of **Night Guard be changed to Youth Care Specialist**. These positions now only guard the residents while they are sleeping and watch over the physical security of the home. We would ask that this position have the same duties and responsibilities, and fall under the same job description as the other Youth Care Specialist. This pay would increase slightly from **\$19.91/hour to \$22.53/ hour**. This is in line with the other positions at the Group Home Direct Care Staff positions. Again, this change would require **NO NEW APPROPRIAITONS** as there is money already budgeted for this in 2025.

Pregnancy Testing: Free, confidential pregnancy testing to give accurate results in a supportive environment. If the test is positive, they also provide free follow-up ultrasounds to confirm the pregnancy.

STI Testing and Prevention: Crossroads Care Clinic is a free full-service STI clinic in partnership with the Indiana State Department of Health.

Services Offered on the Mobile Clinic: The mobile clinic is equipped to provide the same highquality care as the physical location. Walk-ins are welcome for pregnancy testing and STI testing. All services offered on the Mobile Clinic are completely free and confidential.

Parenting Education and Assistance: They offer parenting education and support. Men can attend weekly group classes or one-on-one mentorship sessions to learn alongside other fathers. These Earn While You Learn and 24/7 Dad programs also provide an opportunity to earn "Family Bucks" credit to purchase supplies for the baby, mom and dad. There are similar programs for moms, too.

Mentoring: Crossroads Care Clinic are in partnership with Union Health to help moms and dads through their 2 year mentoring program to develop skills for a healthier home environment for mom, dad and children.

Partnership: Crossroads Care Clinic partners with the Vigo County Health Department, Chances & Services for Youth, Hamilton Center, Family Health and Help Center, and the Lugar Center to implement the Union Health, HRSA funded Healthy Start Initiative: Eliminating Disparities in Perinatal Health.

It is respectfully requested that the following request be discussed at the April, 2025 Council Meeting.

 An additional appropriation for \$64,720.45 to the Law Enforcement Grants line item in the Prosecutor Equitable Sharing budget - 4905.31400.000.0000

The Prosecutor Equitable Sharing budget monies are proceeds received from the United States Government after forfeiture proceedings related to drug investigations have completed where the Vigo County Drug Task Force or other local law enforcement was involved. The United States Department of Justice provides a Guide to Equitable Sharing that details how these funds may be utilized. The guide can be found at https://www.justice.gov/criminal/media/1044326/.

This Law Enforcement Grants line item allows for local law enforcement to request the use of these funds within the parameters of the guidelines. It is anticipated that approximately \$50,000 of this amount will be used for the purchase of a replacement vehicle for the Terre Haute Police Department. Approximately \$11,000 will be used to renew the contract for the Cellebrite system used for cell phone related investigations.

Springhill Road is finally complete and ready to be closed out, after numerous delays. There were no funds appropriated for this line at Budget time last year because it was still unclear what amount would need to be appropriated to cover the many Change Orders on this project. Attached is the final bill from INDOT that I received to complete the Purchase Order and close out the job. This is a total for the Change Orders that Indot considers Non-participating. I have included a summary of the costs associated with the Change Orders and the total. The majority of these Change Orders are a direct result in Utility delays, specifically those from Frontier Communications. I will note that the Commissioners and I will be filing a suit against Frontier Communications for the amount they were responsible for (\$340,328.58). This however could be a lengthy return by the time it is settled in court. Therefore, my request for Additional Appropriation from EDIT will be in the amount of \$381,232.14 to cover the total amount. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact me.
